**Payment for Services:** Bring income verification. You must bring, at least, one of the following: a recent paycheck stub; 1040; W-2; unemployment verification; or Medicaid card. Bring insurance card if you have any kind of health insurance. The verification is required to determine if you are eligible to receive funding assistance. This is a requirement of the State of Illinois. If you are unable to obtain documentation to verify your income or if your reported income does not qualify you for funding assistance, you must pay cash for assessment and treatment prior to the services.
