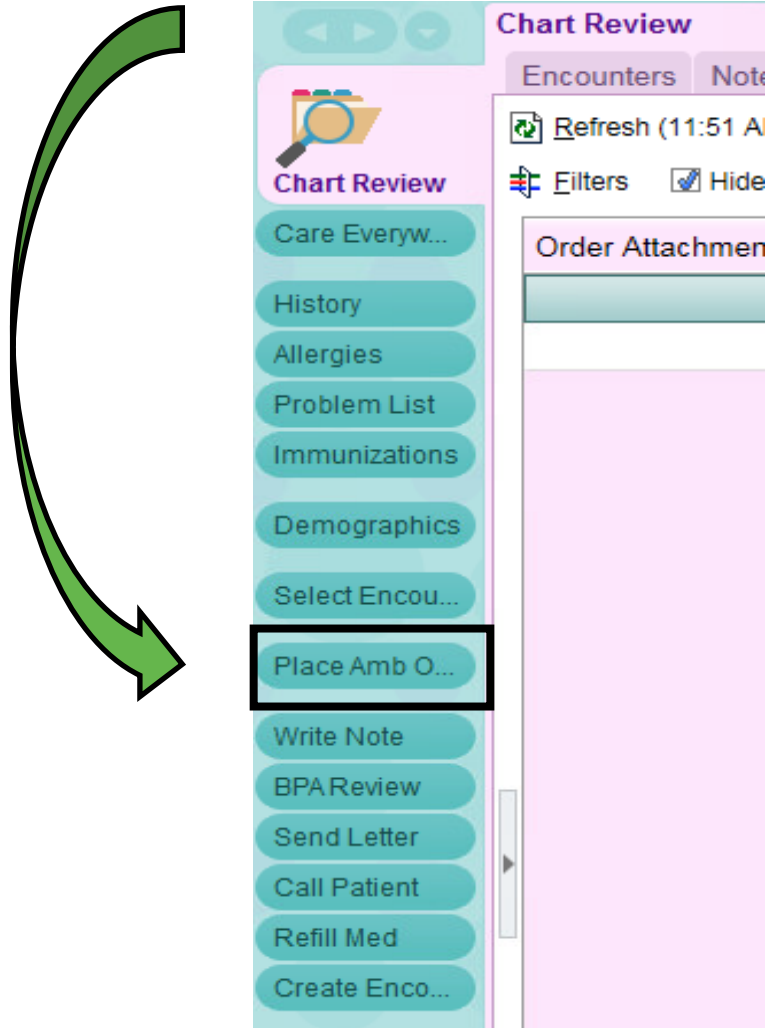


Ambulatory Referral to Diabetic Education:

The steps outlined below will walk you through the process of placing an Ambulatory Referral for Diabetic Education.

- 1) When the patient's chart is open and you are in a Chart Review setting, on the left you will have an option to **Place Amb. Order**, select this.



- This option will allow you to create an Orders Only Encounter to place your referral.

- 2) In the Rooming tab, in the **Meds & Orders section**, search for **Ambulatory Referral to Diabetic Education or Ref 20**.
